2. **1-800-GOT-JUNK?** ([www.1800gotjunk.com](http://www.1800gotjunk.com)) will accept any junk except for hazardous waste materials.
3. **Salt Lake Valley Health Department** ([www.slvhealth.org](http://www.slvhealth.org)) will accept hazardous waste materials such as paint, antifreeze, fertilizer, oil and household chemicals in original packaging. They will also accept car batteries and e-waste such as computers, monitors, laptops, printers, cell phones, and so forth. (For working computer equipment, see **inQuo** below.)
4. **IKEA** ([www.ikea.com/us/en/store/draper](http://www.ikea.com/us/en/store/draper)) is offering 20%-60% discounts on select organizing items throughout the day as well as donating refreshments. They will also provide bins for dropping off your cardboard and plastic for recycling.
