Volunteer Stats:

12 Organizers present – 70 hours (day of event)

5 Vendors – 64 on-site hours

Event Turnout Stats: (Where they learned about the event)

Media – 40, Via Organizers – 25, IKEA – 22, Friends & Family – 13, Newspaper – 10, Library – 8, Newspaper (including Catalyst) – 10, Internet – 3, Flyer – 2, Napo – 1

Busiest time of day: The last hour of the event 2:00pm to 3:00pm - rush at 2:30pm

People Served: 124 cars came through the drop off event

Collection stats:

1. Deseret Industries: One FULL pod (Second pod started)
2. Used Book Collection: Central Book Exchange – 400 to 500 books (they lost count)
3. IKEA – 5 containers cardboard
4. Household Hazardous Waste Collection:

Total Customers: 56 vehicles delivered waste
3 vehicles rejected

Total collected: 4,297 lbs.
